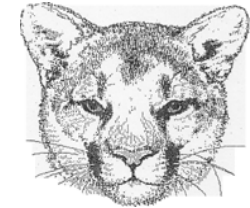

### Academic Focus



The mission of Spring Creek Elementary is to empower students to be life-long learners and productive, cooperative citizens. With a school wide emphasis on environmental education, high academic expectations are achieved by focusing on the teaching of skills in an active learning climate with appropriate interventions and enrichment. Spring Creek is also a full-time gifted center and offers opportunities for those requiring greater academic challenges.

Technology is used daily as a tool for developing the writing process, reviewing, reinforcing and extending math and reading skills, and providing monitored access for research and production.

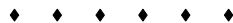
Spring Creek groups students for reading classes, incorporates the Accelerated Math program in third, fourth and fifth grades, provides for enrichment in science by offering the lab called Discovery Zone, and offers unique classes in multi-cultural studies.



Academic celebration days are planned to culminate learning units. Experiences include guest speakers, costumes, cooking, fine arts, parent-assisted projects and field trips. Family involvement is encouraged and promoted. Opportunities include parent workshops, family tutoring, community outreach evenings, and family reading gatherings. Preparing students to learn includes implementing a school wide curriculum of responsibility that is firm, fair and consistent. Activities and after school clubs, which enhance the individual talents of the child, are offered on campus in addition to the fee-supported After School Enrichment Program.

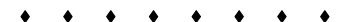
